Dental
Veneers





Dental veneers are often used to create the ultimate smile makeover as it is possible to use veneers to transform crooked, stained, damaged or badly worn teeth into a brand new, straight, white smile. A dental veneer is a thin layer of porcelain made to fit over the front surface of a tooth, like a false fingernail fits over a nail. Sometimes a natural colour 'composite' material is used instead of porcelain.

Veneers make teeth look natural and healthy, and because they are very thin and are held in place by a special strong bond (rather like super-glue) very little preparation of the tooth is needed.

The tooth for veneers is prepared by removing a small amount of enamel surface so the veneer can be bonded permanently in place later. A local anaesthetic may be used to prevent discomfort, but often this is not required. When the tooth has been prepared the dentist will take a mould or impression and this is sent to the dental laboratory for the veneer to be made. This is matched perfectly to your surrounding teeth to ensure it looks entirely natural.

A veneer takes two visits usually with a week or two weeks between appointments. Before bonding it in place the dentist will show you your veneer in place to make sure you are happy with it. Minor adjustments to the fit can be made once the veneer has been bonded in place.



Dental veneers can last for many years provided they are properly maintained, however they can chip or break, just like natural teeth. Small chips can be repaired or new veneers fitted if necessary.
